

Inclusion Bucketball



“Who wants to play?”

This game reminds us that we can make a difference to others, one person at a time, by letting them know they are “seen,” just like Rev. Chris talked about in his sermon last week. All it takes is a few words - like an invitation to sit with you or some kind words to show you care. The more you make an effort, the more we grow as an inclusive community.

- Start with one Bucket (which represents a person) on the edge of the foul line.
- On “GO” each team will attempt to toss a bean bag (inclusive words or invites) into their bucket
- If the bag goes in, that team adds another bucket (person) to their group (pile).
- The newly placed bucket must touch the bucket that was there prior to the toss
- If you miss the bucket... Keep tossing (inviting)
- The game is over when you have 6 buckets and one bean bag in each bucket.
