



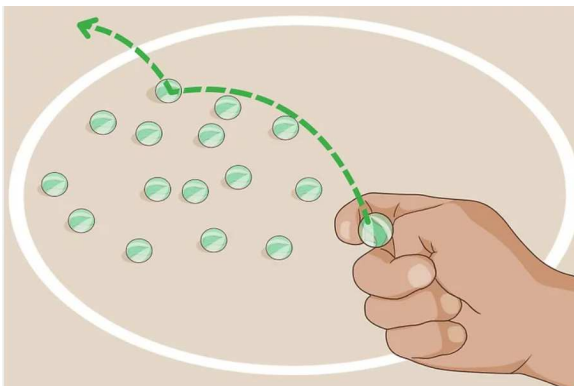
Move Apart & Move Together

Each day we face decisions that ask us to make a choice: be part of a culture that excludes others or be part of what makes this community more inclusive. An old-fashioned game of marbles gives us a way to see that inclusion is something we all work on together.

- Lay out the string (from your bag) in a big circle.
- Find the big shooter marble in your marble bag.
- Place the other marbles inside the circle. Set them up in a pattern (like an X) or just spread them out.

Round 1: Moving Apart

- Taking turns, use the shooter marble to knock the other marbles out, one at a time. The object is to find a spot on the circle to shoot, and knock at least one marble out of the circle on the first shot.



- Make sure each person gets a turn.

Round 2: Moving Together

- Collect the marbles & set up the game the same way.
- This time while each person tries to shoot a marble out, the rest of the Advisory circles up and uses their hands to make sure that all marbles (even if hit by the shooter) stay in the circle.
