



Frequently Asked Questions about Uniforms St. Mark's Campus (PreK 3-Fifth Grade)

All students in Pre-K 3 through fifth grade are required to wear an Episcopal uniform for the 2025-2026 school year.

What are the uniform items?

- Tops:

All shirts must be purchased through our approved vendor, **Land's End** (school code: **900058975**)

- **Polos** in black, gray, maroon, or white with the Episcopal logo (Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 Episcopal logo not required)
- **Chapel Shirt** (Maroon polo with the Episcopal logo) **first - fifth grade**
 - Worn monthly to Eucharist chapels
- **Spirit Day t-shirt (provided)** worn on Fridays

- Bottoms: (solid black, gray, khaki)

In addition to Land's End, khaki bottoms - **skirts/skorts, shorts, and pants** - may also be purchased from other vendors.

- **Shorts:** Must be longer than mid-thigh
- **Pants**
- **Skirts/Skorts:** Must be longer than mid-thigh

- Dresses:

All dresses and jumpers must be purchased through our approved vendor, **Land's End** (school code: **900058975**)

- **Tennis dress** (maroon, gray, or black with courtesy shorts underneath): Must be longer than mid-thigh
- **Jumper** (khaki or gray): Must be longer than mid-thigh

What is Chapel Attire?

- **Maroon polo** with the Episcopal logo and **khaki bottoms**
- **First - fifth grade** students must have at least one maroon logoed shirt/dress for specific chapel days and on field trips (*we recommend purchasing 2 maroon shirts/dresses*).
- Uniform outerwear may be worn over the Chapel shirt as long as it meets outerwear guidelines.

What types of shoes are acceptable during the school day?

- Shoes must be closed-toe and closed-heel, and fully laced or securely fastened at all times for safety.
- Rubber soled shoes are required for Physical Education
- The following are not permitted: sandals, boots (including cowboy boots), recovery shoes, clogs, flip-flops, Crocs, or other novelty footwear
- Socks must be short, matching, and solid in white, gray, khaki, black, dark blue, gold, or maroon (small athletic logos allowed)
- Boots may be worn during cold or rainy weather, with a change of shoes required for PE.

What is acceptable winter wear?

- All students should have uniform options suitable for cold weather, including **at least one pair of dress code pants**.
- When temperatures are **50° or below**, students may wear **knee socks, tights, or leggings** (white, gray, black or maroon): with skirts/dresses.

What type of outerwear should be worn during the school day?

- **Label all outerwear with your child's name.**
- **Episcopal sweaters, sweatshirts, and jackets** are the primary outerwear items and can be purchased from the Campus Store or through an Episcopal School of Jacksonville sponsored activity.
- Outerwear must fit properly and may not be longer than the uniform skirt or dress.
- Non-Episcopal outerwear must be predominantly **white, gray, khaki, brown, black, dark blue, gold, or maroon**.
- Only **one small, non-objectionable emblem** is permitted.

What types of accessories are acceptable?

- In good taste, keeping with a Christian environment
- **Not distracting** to the student or to others
- Earrings should be small enough so they will not interfere with safety.
- **Belts** must fit properly and **may not include** wording, initials, inappropriate insignias, or offensive embellishments
- For **third through fifth grades**, belts are **encouraged** when bottoms have belt loops.

What are the policies concerning hair?

- Hair must be **neatly cut, clean, and kept out of the face**.
- **Distracting hairstyles or colors** are not permitted.
- Boys' hair must not touch their shoulders.

What is Spirit Dress?

- Students may wear their **provided Spirit shirt** with **uniform bottoms** on **Fridays**.

Where can I buy uniforms?

- **The Parents' Association sponsors a Uniform Recycle Program** for gently used uniforms.

- Families are encouraged to attend the **Lands' End Fit Event** during the summer.
